## Royal Sydney Yacht Squadron (RSYS)

RSYS is the host club for the Regatta.

The attached Handout sets out information about the Club facilities during the Regatta.

### Opening hours

The top gate will be open to receive boats between 7am and sunset from Wednesday 15 to Sunday 19 February.

Bar hours are 7.30am to 10pm.

### RSYS racing and tender service

There will be no twilight racing on Tuesday 21 February or Friday 24 February.

The tender service will use the fuel wharf from Wednesday 15 February to Sunday 26 February. All pick up and drop off for yachts will be on the outside of the outer pontoon between these dates.

### Cranes

Boat cranes will operate from 8am to 6pm from Wednesday 15 to Sunday 19 February. Cranes must be operated only by the nominated volunteers.

### Trots

During registration and measurement, we will be using some of the trots to moor non-competing boats to get them off the hardstand, so not all trots will be available before Sunday afternoon. If your allocated mooring is available, please use it. From Sunday evening, all trots will be available and you must use your allocated mooring.

### Fueling

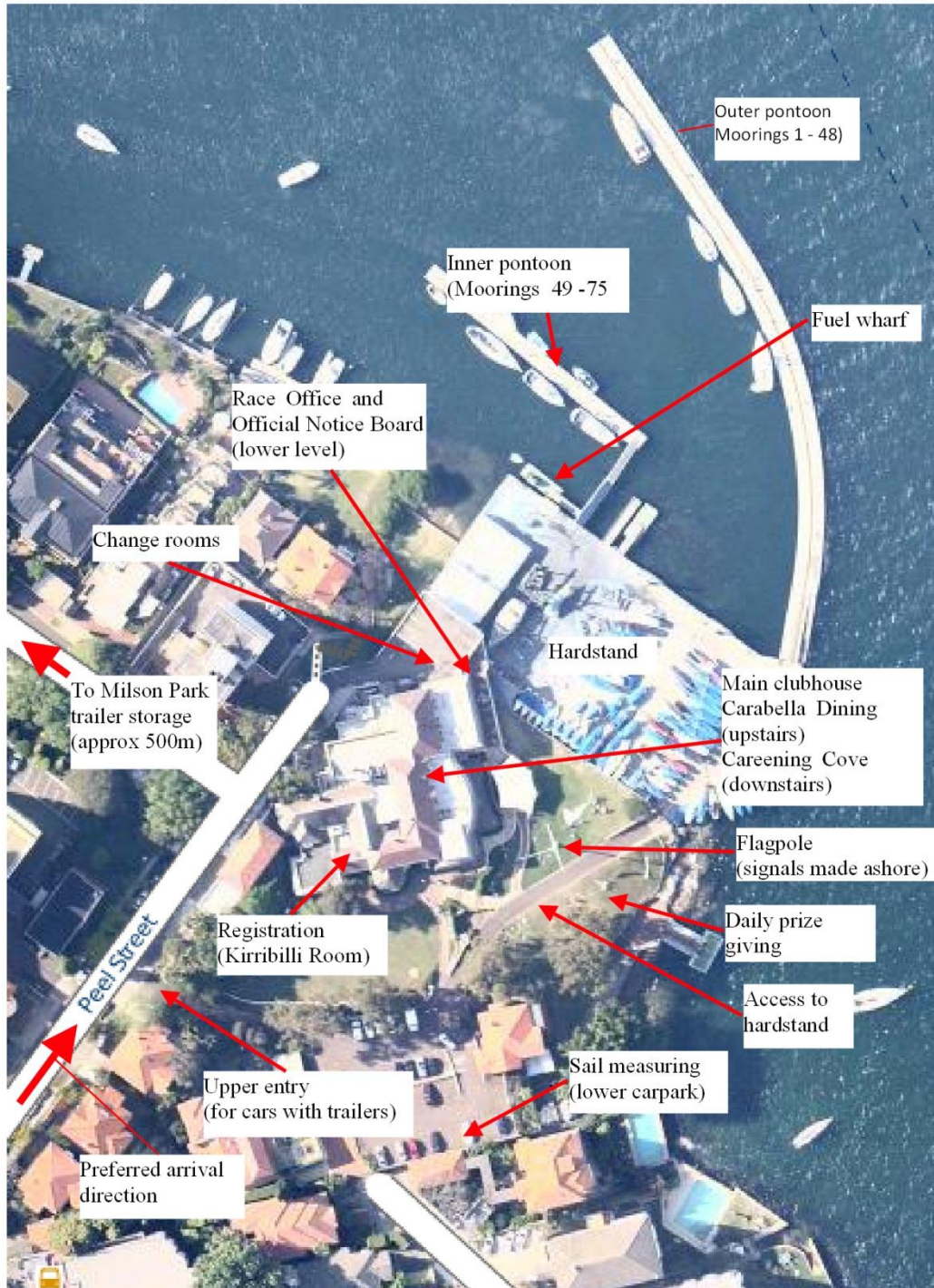
The fuel wharf will be open for refuelling between 7.30am and 10am each day. Payment is by credit card or House Account – no cash.

### Access to equipment

You can leave your gear/dock boxes on the pontoon near your mooring, or on your trailer at Milson Park. We will run a tender service from the fuel wharf to Milson Park.

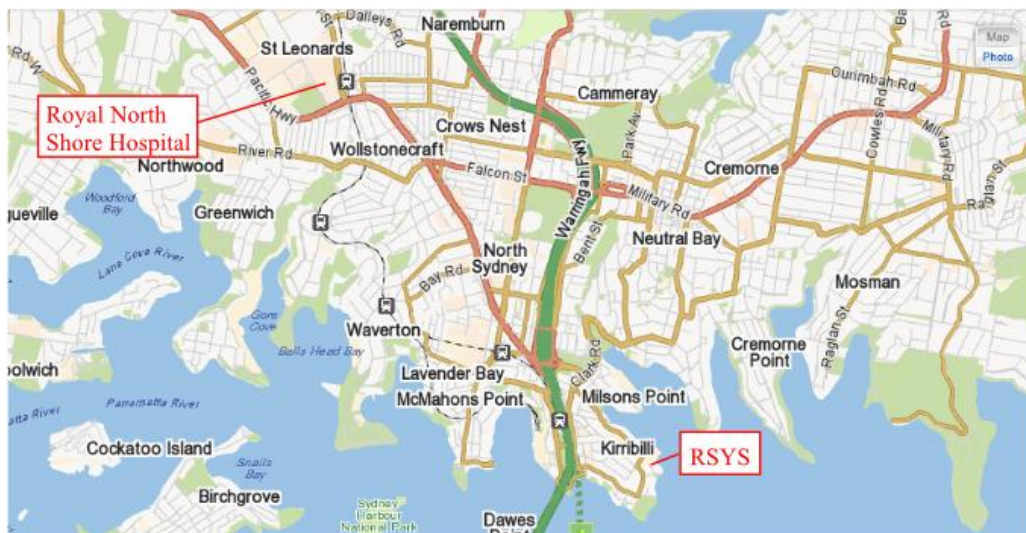
